## **Alum Officer Job Description**

Whilst not necessarily part of the day-to-day running of the SU, the role is a vital part of the Executive Committee as it is their job to ensure that the SU continues to grow and increase Alum relations and donations. The primary function of the role is to increase Alum relations both at a club and SU level.
