

SPORTS UNION INCLUSION OFFICER – JOB DESCRIPTION

Role Title: Sports Union Inclusion Officer – International Students *

** The role will have a focus for a three year period. From 2019 – 2022, this focus is on the inclusion of International Students.*

Responsible to: Sports Union President
Sports Union Executive Committee
Sports Union Membership

Requirements to run: Must be a matriculated student of the University at the time of election and during time in role, and ideally an international student (non-UK).

Recommended skills / experience: Experience of promoting student sport at University – e.g. through leadership positions in a club or intramural team.
An understanding of international student needs and wants with regards to sport at University.
An awareness of Sports Union structure and organisation.
Strong communication, organisational, and planning skills.
Pro-active, and enthusiastic, individual who has the ability to work unsupervised and as part of a team.
Must be committed, and able to contribute time and effort to the role.
Dedication to the improvement of the University's sporting offer.

Key responsibilities: Represent international students by sitting on Sports Union Inclusion Committee, as International Student Inclusion Champion.
Analyse key Sports Union data to promote sport to international students.
Conduct research into barriers to accessing university sport, for international students, through chairing an international student group.
Lead events designed to engage international students across the campus.
Work with Edinburgh Global and EUSA Societies to run specific taster sessions targeted at international students.

Time commitment: 6-8 hours per academic week.
Be able to attend various Sports Union meetings throughout the year.
