

## EDINBURGH UNIVERSITY SPORTS UNION KIT POLICY

### **General**

- PlayerLayer are the official kit supplier of all Edinburgh University Sports Union clubs.
- All clubs must use PlayerLayer as their leisure, training, and playing kit supplier\*.
- This allows all clubs to purchase leisure, training, and playing kit, ensuring all clubs have access to a standardised design which will help promote their club, the University of Edinburgh and the Sports Union.
- Clubs must wear PlayerLayer leisure and playing kit to all official engagement, fixtures and training.

### **Specifics**

- All bulk bespoke playing, training, and leisurewear kit orders are to be made through PlayerLayer. The lead times on these orders are 12 weeks.
- Standard leisurewear orders are to be made through the PlayerLayer Website, with each club having the club name embroidered beneath their items. Orders are made by individuals. Delivery times are 10 working days with delivery to individual addresses.
- Bespoke orders placed prior to the summer break for delivery at the start of the 23/24 academic year carry a standard 18-week lead-time. This is because a more sustainable method of shipment is used, sea freight. To ensure delivery for your first BUCS fixture back, please place these orders by 05/05.
- All Club members are required to exclusively wear PlayerLayer clothing whilst representing the University of Edinburgh at any event, tournament or fixture. This does NOT mean that clubs can buy non-PlayerLayer kit for other occasions.
- The official home playing kit colour is green\*\*.
- The official away playing kit colour is red\*\*.
- The official crest all clubs should use is the two colour crest (as displayed above).
- The Sports Union President will sign off any bespoke orders before they can be made.
- This policy also applies to tour kit. PlayerLayer can usually turn around items such as t-shirts in less than the standard lead-time but cannot guarantee this.
- Clubs should consult their Treasurer before confirming any kit orders.
- Clubs who do not follow the kit policy will receive a yellow card, and may be fined, have kit seized, or another penalty as deemed appropriate by the Executive Committee.

\*The only exception to this is if PlayerLayer does not provide playing or training kit for your sport. Before ordering from another supplier, clubs MUST have an exemption and the design approved by the Sports Union President. Any kit from other suppliers will still be expected to follow branding guidelines and use the University of Edinburgh logo.

Exemptions will not be granted for leisurewear or for clubs who do not leave sufficient time for PlayerLayer orders to arrive.

\*\* The only exception to this is if National or International Governing body regulations state otherwise.
