SAFETY POLICY

- All Clubs must be affiliated with their National Governing Bodies (NGB).
- The Sports Union must at the time of registration be supplied with :-
 - (a) an Advisory Safety Code from NGB
 - (b) the Club's Safety Policy
 - (c) An agreement signed by the Club that the Safety Policy will be adhered to at all times
- The Safety Policy must include <u>at least</u> the minimum recommendations of the NGB.
- As part of a member's registration Clubs must make members aware that:
 - (a) the Safety Policy forms an integral part of their membership;
 - (b) breaching of any part of the Safety Policy will deem him/her not to be a member of the Club and that such action is being taken at his/her own risk;
 - (c) all members should have read and understood the Safety Policy;
 - (d) any reports of breaking the Safety Policy will result in disciplinary action.
- All clubs that are required to do so **MUST** return a completed <u>Trip Registration</u> <u>form</u> 48 hours prior to the trip's departure.
- Suitably qualified person(s) must accompany all trips.
- Suitable First Aid provision must be made for all trips.
