



# Sustainability Plan Transport 23/24

## Carbon Offsetting

Clubs will be given the opportunity, each time they book transport via the SU, to offset their emissions through a donation to the Woodland Trust. The donation is calculated based on number of tonnes in CO2 emitted on the trip (based on distance, passenger numbers and travel method).

## SRS Emissions Monitoring & Reporting

We will record emission data from SU transport. Emissions will be calculated on a yearly basis with the aim of reducing annually. The club with the lowest emissions on a person-by-person basis will have the opportunity to attend the Big Dig event to plant saplings on University estate.

## Ecological Driving

All new authorised drivers will complete a mandatory ecological driving module as part of the driver induction process. The aim of the module is to promote eco-friendly driving behaviours to help reduce fuel consumption of the road.

## Coach, Vehicle Sharing & Public Transport

We will increase the number of coach and vehicle shares by informing clubs of other teams travelling to the same destination. This will save costs and reduce emissions between clubs. We will promote the use of public transport to our clubs and assist with the booking of trains.

## Limit Air Travel

We will limit the frequency of travelling by air to away fixtures and strongly advise against this form of transport for university sports fixtures and events.

## Club Reminders & Advice Pack

Clubs will receive reminders with booking confirmations and an advice pack with good practice will be shared on our website. Clubs will be encouraged to think outside the box to act sustainably when organising transport.
